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What you will be working on at Our Co-op

1. Direct Care of the Deceased

 You'll be responsible for looking after the deceased with respect and dignity throughout their time in our care. This involves carefully bringing them into our care, making sure they're properly identified, and keeping their belongings safe. You'll also help prepare and dress them respectfully before their final arrangements. Finally, you'll ensure their respectful transport to various locations as per the family's wishes.

2. Facilitating the Funeral Service

 You'll play a vital role in making sure the funeral service runs smoothly and honours the family's wishes. This involves working closely with the Funeral Director to understand the family's plans and ensure every detail is met. You'll also be responsible for driving the hearse professionally and helping to prepare the coffin. Additionally, you'll provide support to families during visits to the Chapel of Rest and help manage other funeral arrangements like floral tributes and the order of service.

3. Maintaining Professionalism

• As a Funeral Operative, you'll be a source of comfort and support for families during a difficult time. This means presenting yourself with a professional demeanour and appearance in all interactions, from families and congregations to staff at crematoria and cemeteries.

4. Ensuring Hygiene and Upkeep

• Keeping a clean and respectful environment is crucial. This involves thoroughly sanitising all designated areas, including the garage, preparation rooms, and mortuary. You'll also be responsible for making sure the funeral vehicles are clean, well-maintained, and stocked with the necessary equipment for each service.

5. Compliance and Flexibility

 Working in this role requires a commitment to following all company policies, legal regulations, and health & safety protocols. This ensures a safe and compliant working environment for everyone involved. Additionally, you'll need to demonstrate flexibility as you may be part of an on-call team, working outside of regular office hours to meet the needs of grieving families.
